DECLARATION: I agree to be bound by the ICF Sailing Rules, the Racing Rules of Sailing, RYA National Prescriptions, IC Class Rules and Sailing Instructions, and to abide by the rules of the Pwllheli Sailing Club & Plas Heli National Sailing Academy. I declare that I hold Comprehensive National Federation Membership, Measurement Certificate, and Third Party Insurance for a minimum liability of £3,000,000, and will produce these on request.

I accept the Conditions of Entry which are that the safety of a boat and its entire management, including insurance, shall be the sole responsibility of the competitor racing the boat, who undertakes to ensure that the boat and its crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of sailing in this Championship event. Neither the sailing instructions, nor any inspection of the boat limits or reduces the absolute responsibility of the competitor for his or her boat and the entire management thereof. The race organisers and the BCU shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury however caused to the competitor as a result of their taking part in a race or races. Moreover, every competitor warrants the suitability of his or her boat for the race or races and is solely responsible for his or her decision whether or not to sail and compete in the weather conditions prevailing at the time.
